

Amish Beef and Moodles

- 4 Tbsp. vegetable oil,
- 2 lb. beef rump roast, cut into 2" cubes
- 2 Tbsp. all-purpose flour
- 4 tsp. kosher salt, devided 1/2 tsp. freshly ground black pepper
- 2 large yellow onions, finley chopped
- 8 cups low sodium beef broth, divided
- 12 oz. wide egg noodles

- In a large pot over medium high heat 2 tablespoons oil. Place beef in large bowl and toss with flour, 2 teaspoons salt and 1/2 teaspoon pepper.
- Add half of beef to pot and cook, turning occasionally, until browned on 2 sides, 4 to 5 minutes. Transfer beef to a plate; repeat with 2 tablespoons oils and beef.
- Reduce heat to medium. Cook onion and 1/2 teaspoon salt, stirring occasionally, until just tender, 5 to 7 minutes. Return beef to pot and add 6 cups broth. Bring to a boil over medium-high heat. Reduce heat to medium-low, cover, and simmer until beef is tender enough to shred with fork, 2 to 2 1/2 hours. transfer beef to a plate and
- shred. Pour remaining 2 cups broth into the same pot and bring to a boil, add noodles and cook until tender. Return beef to pot, toss and add reaming salt and serve.



Boundaries are South Miller to Captain Cook











