
services and activities. I will share more details upon our launch, at the beginning of October.

CREAMY LEMON CHICKEN

3 Large chicken breast

1/2 teaspoon salt

1/4 teaspoon black pepper

6 tablespoon flour

2 tablespoons olive oil

2 tablespoons unsalted butter

3 cloves garlic

cup chicken stock

ı cup heavy cream

4 teaspoons fresh lemon juice

1/2 cup parmesan cheese



Season chicken with salt and pepper, then dredge n flour and shake off any excess. In skillet heat olive oil and I tablespoon butter on medium heat, add chicken and brown. Transfer to plate. Melt I tablespoon of butter and saute the garlic for a minute, add the chicken stock and deglaze pan. Adjust the heat to medium-low and add heavy cream, lemon juice and parmesan cheese to the skillet. Allow to gently simmer for a couple minutes. Season with salt and pepper to taste and add chicken back to the pan, let thicken a few minutes.

Serve over rice or potatoes.




Good bye to a few of our snow birds. They are flying South for the winter, lucky ducks. We will miss you guys, see you in the spring!
